When you are discouraged



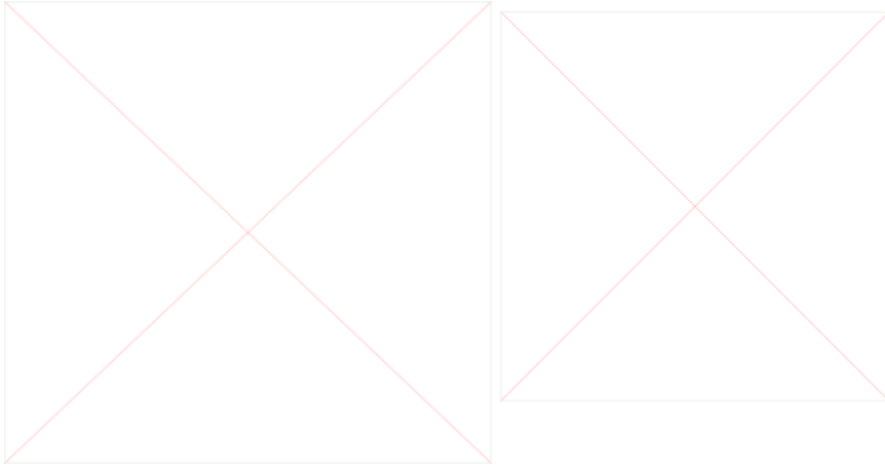

Isa 40 :31 : But those who hope in the LORD will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not faint.

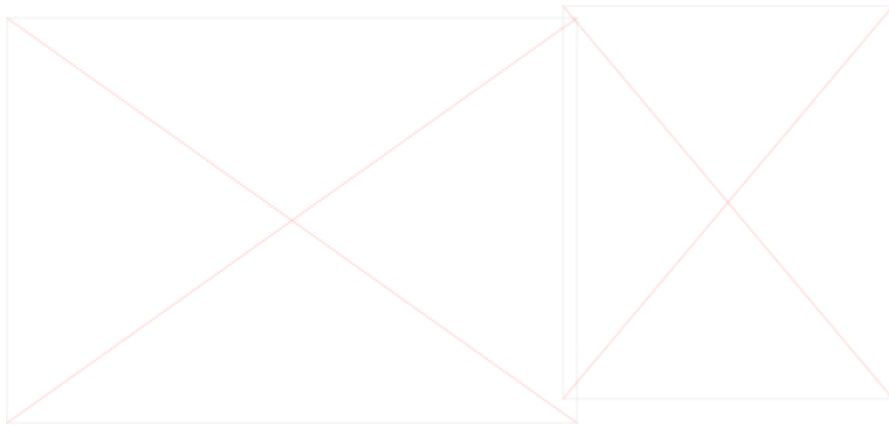
When you are guilty of sin

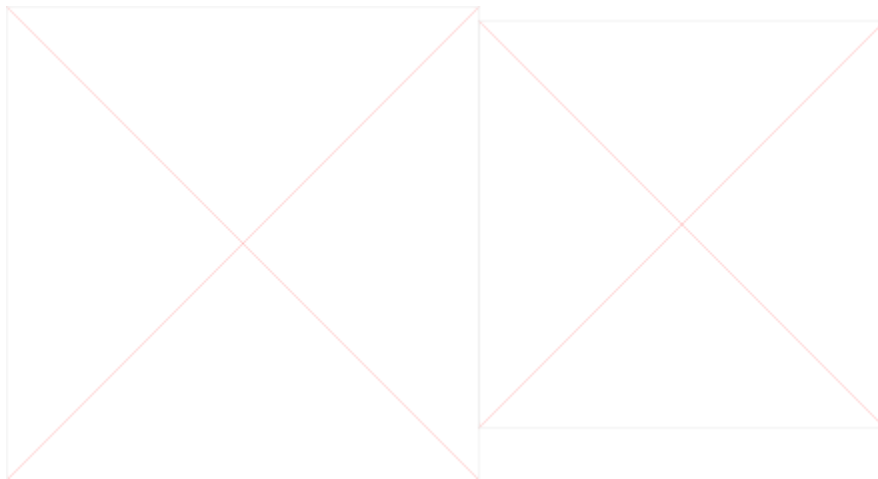

John 16:33: “I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world.”

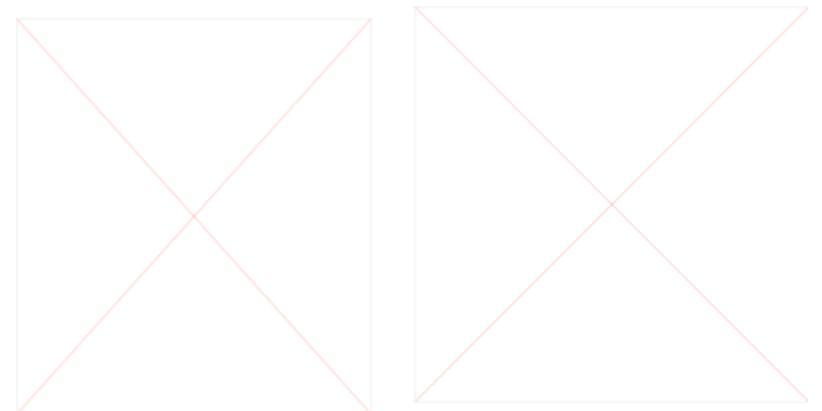

11. I Timothy 1 :17 : Now to the King eternal, immortal, invisible, the only God be honor, and Glory for ever and ever Amen.

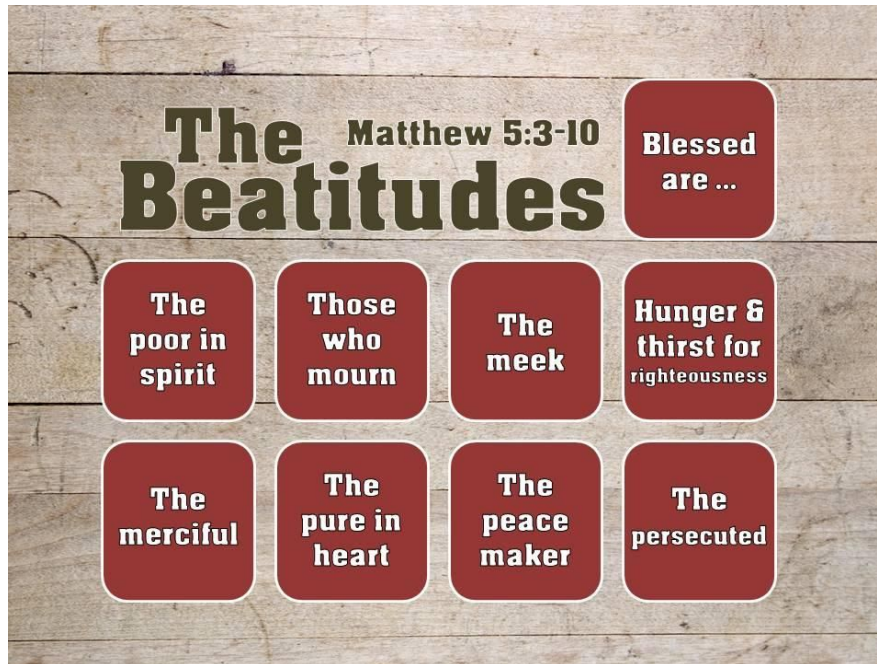
12. I Peter 4:13: Rejoice that you participate in the sufferings of Christ so that you may be overjoyed when his Glory is revealed.

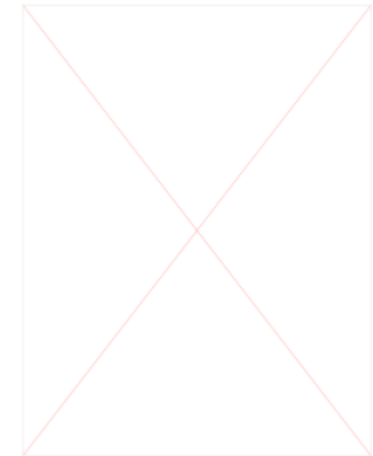

HEBREWS 11 , HALL OF FAITH (OLD TESTAMENT FAITH WARRIORS)



By faith **Abel** offered a better sacrifice than Cain (Hebrews 11:4)

By faith, **Enoch** did not see death, but was changed from mortal to immortal by God (Hebrews 11:5);

By faith, **Noah** was convicted to build an ark to save his household from the flood (Hebrews 11:7)

By faith, **Abraham** left his people and went out to establish a new nation where God led him (Hebrews 11:8-10).
