### When you are discouraged





### When you are lonely




Matt 28:20: And teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”

**Isa 40 :31** : But those who hope in the LORD will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not faint.


## When you are guilty of sin






### **Memory Verse in Class**

1	“This is the covenant I will make with the people of Israel after that time,” declares the Lord. “I will put my law in their minds and write it on their hearts. I will be their God, and they will be my people. ( Jeremiah 31 : 33 )
---	--

2	For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him. ( John 3 : 16-17 )
3	But because of his great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions—it is by grace you have been saved. (Ephesians 2:4-5)
4	For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— not by works, so that no one can boast. ( Ephesians 2 : 8,9)
5	For the grace of God has appeared that offers salvation to all people. It teaches us to say “No” to ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright and godly lives in this present age ( Titus 2 : 11,12 )
6	I do not set aside the grace of God, for if righteousness could be gained through the law, Christ died for nothing!” ( Galatians 2 : 21 )
7	But by the grace of God I am what I am, and his grace to me was not without effect. No, I worked harder than all of them—yet not I, but the grace of God that was with me. ( 1 Corinthians 15 : 10 )
8	But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you. ( John 14 : 26 )
9	Whether you turn to the right or to the left, your ears will hear a voice behind you, saying, “This is the way; walk in it.” ( Isaiah 30 : 21 )

10	But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law. (Galatians 5:22-23)
11	Jesus replied: “ ‘Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.’ This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: ‘Love your neighbor as yourself.’ All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments.” ( Matthew 22 : 37-40 )
12	Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. (1 Corinthians 13:4-7)
13	And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. ( Ephesians 4 : 30 )
14	If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. (1John 1:9)
15	If God is for us, who can be against us? (Romans 8:31)



HEBREWS 11 , HALL OF FAITH ( OLD TESTAMENT FAITH WARRIORS)



By faith **Abel** offered a better sacrifice than Cain (Hebrews 11:4)

By faith, **Enoch** did not see death, but was changed from mortal to immortal by God (Hebrews 11:5);

By faith, **Noah** was convicted to build an ark to save his household from the flood (Hebrews 11:7)

By faith, **the Israelites** marched around Jericho for seven days and saw the Lord destroy the walls (Hebrews 11:30)

By faith, **Rahab** risked her life to accommodate the Hebrew spies seeking to overthrow the city (Hebrews 11:31).
