When you are discouraged





When you are lonely




Matt 28:20: And teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”

Isa 40 :31 : But those who hope in the LORD will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not faint.


When you are guilty of sin


14 : 1 : "Do not let your hearts be troubled. You believe in God believe also in me.







Nebuchanezzar's Dream : Daniel 4:37 - Now I, Nebuchadnezzar, praise and exalt and glorify the King of heaven, because everything he does is right and all his ways are just. And those who walk in pride he is able to humble.

Belshazaar and the writing on the wall : Hebrews 10:26,27 - For if we go on sinning deliberately after receiving the knowledge of the truth, there

no longer remains a sacrifice for sins, but a fearful expectation of judgment, and a fury of fire that will consume the adversaries.


Daniel in the Lion's Den: Daniel 6:27 - He delivers and rescues; he works signs and wonders

Rebuilding the temple : Ezra 6:3 - In the first year of King Cyrus, the king issued a decree concerning the temple of God in Jerusalem: Let the temple be rebuilt as a place to present sacrifices, and let its foundations be laid.

HEBREWS 11 , HALL OF FAITH (OLD TESTAMENT FAITH WARRIORS)



By faith **Abel** offered a better sacrifice than Cain (Hebrews 11:4)

By faith, **Enoch** did not see death, but was changed from mortal to immortal by God (Hebrews 11:5);

By faith, **Noah** was convicted to build an ark to save his household from the flood (Hebrews 11:7)

By faith, **Abraham** left his people and went out to establish a new nation where God led him (Hebrews 11:8-10).

By faith, **Abraham** obeyed God by offering his son Isaac as a sacrifice, knowing that God would resurrect him (Hebrews 11:17-19)

By faith, **Sarah** was able to conceive children in her old age, whose descendants were as numerous as the stars (Hebrews 11:11-12)

By faith, **Isaac** blessed Jacob and Esau so that they would fulfill God's calling (Hebrews 11:20)
