### HEBREWS 11, HALL OF FAITH (OLD TESTAMENT FAITH WARIORS)



By faith Abel offered a better sacrifice than Cain (Hebrews 11:4)

By faith, **Enoch** did not see death, but was changed from mortal to immortal by God (Hebrews 11:5;

By faith, **Noah** was convicted to build an ark to save his household from the flood (Hebrews 11:7)

By faith, **Abraham** left his people and went out to establish a new nation where God led him (Hebrews 11:8-10).

By faith, **Abraham** obeyed God by offering his son Isaac as a sacrifice, knowing that God would resurrect him (Hebrews 11:17-19)

By faith, **Sarah** was able to conceive children in her old age, whose descendants were as numerous as the stars (Hebrews 11:11-12)





knowing that God would resurrect him (Hebrews 11:17-19)

By faith, **Isaac** blessed Jacob and Esau so that they would fulfill God's calling (Hebrews 11:20)
