OPERATION GOOD SAMARITAN

In association with The PRESTIGE Group & The All India Anglo Indian Guild

On the request of **Mr. Bhaskar Rao, Bangalore Police Commissioner**, the **PRESTIGE Group** donated 500 bags of dry rations to the Anglo-Indian Guild for distribution to the poor and needy Anglo-Indians and others.

On **30th April 2020**, a small function was held at Maria Niketan, Cooke Town when the **Police Commissioner Mr. Bhaskar Rao**, flagged off the distribution. **The Anglo-Indian Guild** had sent in a request to **St. Mark's Cathedral** to be involved in the distribution in view of the experience that they had already acquired.
