

Report on visit to Rainbow home

Rainbow Home is a shelter for 55 destitute girls ranging from 0-19 years, located at Wilson Garden the Home currently has no sponsors at this time of lockdown.

Tarun Paul, member of the youth fellowship suggested that the youth should reach it out this home and help in whatever way possible.

On communicating with them we found out they needed provisions and toiletries. Knowing that the provisions requirement was similar to that The Good Samaritan team have been distributing. The Youth Fellowship reached out the Good Samaritan team to help, to which they gladly accepted and provided 15 bags to meet their requirements. To cater to the toiletries, we needed a sum total of Rs.7960, of which we requested an amount of Rs.5510 from the youth budget and Rs. 2450 was contributed by Sushant Joshua.

On May 16, 2020 the youth of St. Mark's together with the Good Samaritan team visited the children of Rainbow home. It was a good time of fellowship as we sang and prayed together as one.
